In celebration of World Refugee Day, ICMC Europe in collaboration with Amnesty Ixelles, Caritas International and Serve the City Brussels will bring the ART WORKS Projects (AWP) outdoor video projection of Sanctuary/Sustenance 'The story of many stories' to Brussels.

We invite you to join us on Place Flagey to observe World Refugee Day through visuals, music and an open debate, exploring the topic of displacement and tracing the journey of refugees toward sanctuary and rebuilding life in a new community. The outdoor video projection of <u>Sanctuary/Sustenance</u> is part of a global initiative that has been exhibited in 68 cities across 6 continents to raise awareness on the tremendous journeys refugees undertake before arriving to our communities.
